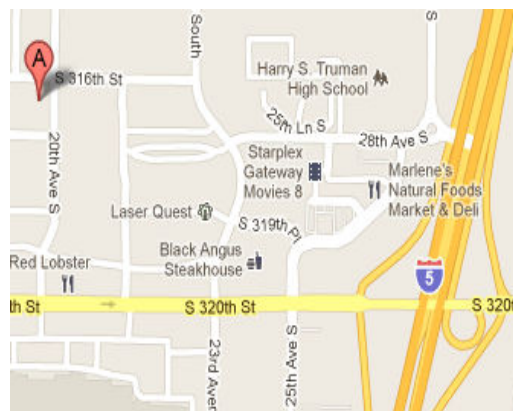
DRIVING DIRECTIONS

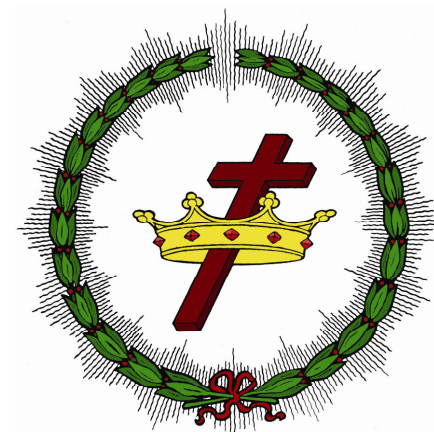
