We do not war according to the flesh




For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the deeds of the body, you will live. – Romans 8:13 *NRSV*



What are these Mighty Weapons for?


The Church's weapons are:

Mighty through God to the pulling down of strongholds. – 2 Corinthians 10:4 KJV


Divinely powerful for the destruction of fortresses. – 2 Corinthians 10:4 NASV


Mighty Weapons Cast Down "High Things"

Destroying speculations and every lofty thing raised up against the knowledge of God – NASV



A 346 – Concluding Thoughts Are you still willing . . . to give up your own plans and methods? theories of yourself and others? to accept God's plan, way and time?




Obedience of Christ




Obedience of Christ
