<p>Some Unique Features:</p> <p>Moses provides and slays the offerings.</p> <p>One animal for sin and burnt offerings.</p> <p>High priest AND underpriests both shown in picture and both lay hands on the animals.</p> <p>Ram of consecration – blood put on the high priest and underpriests.</p> <p>Wave offerings.</p>	<p>Some Unique Features:</p> <p>Two animals (bullock & ram) offered as burnt offerings after second (church's) sin offering.</p> <p>Aaron blesses the people as the sacrifices burn.</p> <p>Moses and Aaron bless the people.</p> <p>The glory of the Lord appears to the people, fire comes down from heaven and consumes the burnt offering.</p> <p>The people shout and fall on their faces.</p>	<p>Some Unique Features:</p> <p>The congregation was NOT invited to observe the sacrificing.</p> <p>High Priest enters the Holy and Most Holy.</p> <p>Three fires: incense offered on golden altar.</p> <p>Blood is sprinkled on the mercy seat in the form of a cross.</p> <p>The scapegoat sacrifice is unlike any other offering provided.</p>
